A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

1 To amend eligibility for a reserved disability parking space to accommodate off-street parking
2 that is inaccessible to a dwelling; and to amend the Safe at Home Act of 2016 to include
3 modifications to enable or facilitate access from to and from an off-street parking space
4 as an accessibility modification for the Safe at Home Program.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may
7 be cited as the “Access to Home Amendment Act of 2023”.

8 Sec. 2. Chapter 27 of Title 18 of DCMR is amended as follows:

9 (a) Section 2710 (18 DCMR § 2710) is amended to read as follows:

10 “2710.1 The Director may reserve one (1) on-street parking space for any District
11 resident who applies in writing for a reserved space and who:

12 “(a) Holds a valid license plate or permit for a person with a physical disability issued by
13 the District pursuant to § 2701.1 (a), (b), (c), (d) and (e);

14 “(b) Is legally domiciled at a single-family residence in the District of Columbia that is
15 her or his principal place of residence;

16 “(d) Certifies that the resident has no readily available parking within a distance that is
17 reasonably accessible for the resident; and

18 “(e) Certifies that a reserved parking space is reasonably necessary to accommodate the
19 resident’s access to the dwelling and, if ingress to the dwelling is also available from off-street
20 parking in a driveway, garage, or other private area, further certifies that such off-street parking
21 is less accessible than a reserved on-street parking space due to the resident’s disability.

22 Sec. 3. Subsection 2(c) of the Safe at Home Act of 2016, effective November 26, 2016
23 (D.C. Law 21-168; D.C. Official Code § 7-551.01(c)), is amended as follows:

24 (a) Paragraph (7) is amended by striking the word “and”.

25 (b) A new paragraph (7A) to read as follows:

26 “(7A) Modifications to enable or facilitate access from to and from an off-street
27 parking space;”.

28 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

29 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
30 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
31 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

32 Sec. 4. Effective date.

33 This act shall take effect after approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
34 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as

35 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
36 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
37 Columbia Register.
