







A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

1 To amend the Police Officer and Firefighter Cadet Programs Funding Authorization and Human  
2 Rights Act of 1977 Amendment Act of 1982 to widen the recruiting age for the  
3 Metropolitan Police Department Cadet Program and to increase the starting salary of  
4 cadets in the program.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this  
7 act may be cited as the “Compensation and Development of Extraordinary Trainees (CADET)  
8 Amendment Act of 2023”.

9 Sec. 2. Section 2 of the Police Officer and Firefighter Cadet Programs Funding  
10 Authorization and Human Rights Act of 1977 Amendment Act of 1982, effective March 9, 1983  
11 (D.C. Law 4-172; D.C. Official Code § 5-109.01), is amended as follows:

12 (a) Subsection (a)(2) is amended to read as follows:

13           “(a)(2) The police officer cadet program established in paragraph (1) of this subsection  
14 shall be composed of the following persons residing in the District, or who shall have substantial  
15 ties to the District, such as currently or formerly residing, attending school, or working in the  
16 District for a significant period of time:

17                   (A) Senior-year high school students;

18                   (B) High school graduates or high school equivalency degree holders, between 18  
19 and 33 years of age; or

20                   (C) Be between the ages of 18 and 33 years of age at the time of hire.

21           (b) A new section (d) is added to read as follows:

22                   “(d) The minimum payment amount for the MPD Cadet Corps shall be greater than or  
23 equal to 174% of the District living wage pursuant to the Living Wage Act of 2006, effective  
24 June 8, 2006 (D.C. Law 16-118; D.C. Official Code § 2-220.01 *et seq.*) (“Living Wage Act”).”

25           Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

26           The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal  
27 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,  
28 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

29           Sec. 4. Effective date.

30           This act shall take effect after approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the  
31 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as  
32 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December  
33 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of  
34 Columbia Register.
