13 To require, on an emergency basis, the District Department of Transportation to remove three
14 trees located near the property line of 450 Xenia Street S.E., in Ward 8.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
16
17 act may be cited as the “Xenia Street Tree Relocation Emergency Act of 2023”.

18 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the prohibition in Section 2 of the Tree Protection Amendment
19 Act of 2000, effective June 19, 2001 (D.C. Law 13-314; D.C. Official Code § 10-731) or any
20 other provision of law, the District Department of Transportation shall relocate the two trees
21 located on or near the property line and walkway of 450 Xenia Street S.E. no later than August
22 11, 2023.

23 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

24 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact
25 statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved
26 October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

27 Sec. 4. Effective date.

28 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
29 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than
30 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section

- 31 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788;
- 32 D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
