21	grants, including grants in excess of \$1 million, to the National Park Service for the purpose of
22	planning, designing, constructing, making improvements to, or maintaining parks and trails
23	within the Buzzard Point neighborhood.".

34	provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24,
35	1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
36	Columbia Register.
37	(b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
