A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend, on an emergency basis, due to congressional review, the Immunization of School Students Act of 1979 to remove the requirement that eligible students in the District of Columbia receive a vaccination against COVID-19; and to repeal the Coronavirus Immunization of School Students Temporary Amendment Act of 2022.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this

- act may be cited as the "School Student Vaccination Congressional Review Emergency
- Amendment Act of 2023".
- Sec. 2. The Immunization of School Students Act of 1979, effective September 28, 1979

 - (a) Section 2 (D.C. Official Code § 38-501) is amended by repealing paragraph (2A).
 - (b) Section 3a (D.C. Official Code § 38-502.01) is repealed.

- provided, that the Mayor may not issue regulations that conflict with the requirements of section
- 29 3a." and inserting a period in its place.
