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| 19 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this |
| 20 | act may be cited as the "Certified Nurse Aide Amendment Act of 2024". |
| 21 | Sec. 2. The District of Columbia Health Occupations Revision Act of 1985, effective |
| 22 | March 25, 1986 (D.C. Law 6-99; D.C. Official Code § 3-1201.01 et seq.), is amended as follows: |
| 23 | (a) Section 204 (D.C. Official Code § 3-1202.04) is amended by adding a new subsection |
| 24 | (h) to read as follows: |
| 25 | "(h) Within 6 months of the effective date of this subsection, the Board shall provide |
| 26 | recommendations to the Mayor for their consideration in developing and issuing rules governing |
| 27 | nursing assistive personnel with the title of certified nurse aides, as described under section |

| 28 | 907(d), in accordance with guidelines approved by the Advisory Committee on Certified Nurse |
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| 29 | Aides and Nursing Assistive Personnel.". |
| 30 31 | (b) Section 907 (D.C. Official Code § 3-1209.07) is amended by adding subsection (d) to |

| 33 | "(d) The Mayor shall, pursuant to the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, |
| 34 | approved October 21, 1968 (82 Stat. 1204; D.C. Official Code § 2-501 et seq.), issue rules setting |

| 36 | which shall include: |

| 45 | Nursing receiving a complete application for a temporary license, the Department of Health shall |

| 55 | "(a) There is established an Advisory Committee on Certified Nurse Aides and Nursing |
| 56 | Assistive Personnel ("Committee"), which shall consist of the following 5 members: |
| 57 | "(1) An individual who has experience working as a home-health aide or a |

| 59 | "(2) Two representatives of providers licensed in the District to provide certified |

| 52 | "(3) One representative from entities approved to train certified nurse aides; and |

| 54 | "(b) The Committee shall develop and submit recommendations to the Board of Nursing |
| 55 | for the certification of certified nurse aides. The guidelines shall set forth the education and |

| 72 | "(d) The Committee shall sunset 2 years after its first meeting.". |

| 75 | (a) Section 3(a) (D.C. Official Code § 4-2002(a)) is amended by striking the numeral |
| 76 | "117.6%" both times it appears and inserting the numeral "120%" in its place. |
| 77 | (b) Section 5 (D.C. Official Code § 4-4004) is amended as follows: |
| 78 | (1) Subsection (a) is amended by striking the numeral "117.6%" wherever it |

| 82 | Sec. 5. Applicability. |
| 83 | (a) Section 4 shall apply upon the date of inclusion of its fiscal effect in an approved |
| 84 | budget and financial plan. |

| 85 | (b) The Chief Financial Officer shall certify the date of the inclusion of the fiscal |
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| 86 | effect in an approved budget and financial plan, and provide notice to the Budget Director of the |
| 87 | Council of the certification. |

| 89 | District of Columbia Register. |
| 90 | (2) The date of publication of the notice of the certification shall not affect the |

| 93 | The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal |
| 94 | impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, |
| 95 | approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a). |
| 96 | Sec. 7. Effective date. |
| 97 | This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the |
| 98 | Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto) and a 30-day period of congressional |
| 99 | review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, |
| 100 | approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)). |
