16	December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 787; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.04), and consistent with the Street
17	and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law
18	4-201; D.C. Official Code § 9-201.01 et seq.), the Council finds that the portion of public alley in
19	Square 3701, as shown on the Surveyor's plat filed under S.O. 23-06220, is unnecessary for alley
20	purposes and orders it closed with title to the land to vest as shown on the Surveyor's plat.
21	(b) The ordering of this alley closing is contingent upon the property owner receiving the
22	requisite public space approvals for parking and loading access prior to the recordation of the
23	plat by the Surveyor.
