10	To amend, on a temporary basis, section 6a of the Construction Codes Approval and
11	Amendments Act of 1986 to require a property owner, contractor, or person applying for
12 13	certain permits for construction work to demonstrate that their insurance provides
13	coverage for adjacent and adjoining property owners for loss or damage that arises out of
14	the proposed construction work.

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
17	act may be cited as the "Protecting Adjacent and Adjoining Property Owners from Construction
18	Damage Temporary Amendment Act of 2024".
19	Sec. 2. Section 6a(a)(2A)(B) of the Construction Codes Approval and Amendments Act of
20	1986, effective April 20, 1999 (D.C. Law 12-261; D.C. Official Code § 6-1405.01(a)(2A)(B)), is
21	amended to read as follows:
22	"(B) The following permits shall require insurance pursuant to subparagraph
23	(A) of this paragraph; provided, that the requirements shall only apply to permits issued 30 days
24	after the adoption of emergency or final rules issued by the Mayor pursuant to subparagraph (E) of
25	this paragraph:
26	"(i) An addition, alteration, and repair permit pursuant to which the
27	applicant will be engaging in <u>underpinning</u> , construction at the property line or on the party wall of
28	an adjacent or adjoining property; or any construction activity for which a permit listed under
29	subparagraph (iii), (iv), (v), (vi), (vii), or (viii) of this paragraph would otherwise be required;

30	"(ii) An alteration and repair; permit pursuant to which the applicant
31	will be engaging in underpinning, construction at the property line or on the party wall of an
32	adjacent or adjoining property, or any construction activity for which a permit listed under
33	subparagraph (iii), (iv), (v), (vi), (vii), or (viii) of this paragraph would otherwise be required;
34	"(iii) A foundation permit;
35	"(iv) A demolition permit;
36	"(v) An excavation permit;
37	"(vi) A new building permit;
38	"(vii) A raze permit; and
39	"(viii) A sheeting and shoring permit.".

45	(a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
46	the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review
47	as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
48	24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
49	Columbia Register.
50	(b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
