IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

---

To symbolically designate, on an emergency basis, the portion of the public alley system within Square 0179 abutting Lot 111, as Annie’s Way and to repeal the previous designation of Annie’s Way.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Annie’s Way Designation Emergency Act of 2024”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401, 403a, and 423 of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code §§ 9-204.01, 9-204.03a, and 9-204.23), the Council symbolically designates the portion of the public alley system within Square 0179 abutting Lot 111, as “Annie’s Way”.

Sec. 3. The Annie’s Way Designation Act of 2014, effective April 30, 2014 (D.C. Law 20-99; 61 DCR 1594), is repealed.

Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

Sec. 5. Effective date.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section
