IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To designate the Ballou Senior High School football stadium with a permanent location at 3401 4<sup>th</sup> Street, S.E in Ward 8 as the Michael A. Locksley Football Stadium.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Michael A. Locksley Football Stadium Designation Act of 2024”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401 and 422(b) through (e) of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code §§ 9-204.01 and 9-204.22(b) through (e)) (“Act”), and notwithstanding section 422(a) of the Act (D.C. Official Code § 9-204.22(a)), the Council designates the library at Ballou Senior High School, at 3401 4<sup>th</sup> Street, S.E., in Ward 8 as “Michael A. Locksley Football Stadium”.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

Sec. 4. Effective date.

33           This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto  
34 by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of  
35 congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home  
36 Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-  
37 206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of Columbia Register.
