## IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To symbolically designate 2465 Alabama Avenue, S.E., between Gainesville Street, S.E. and Hartford Street, S.E., as Reverend Dr. Judy Talbert Designation Act 2024.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Reverend Dr. Judy Talbert Street Designation Act of 2024"

Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401, 403, and 421 of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code §§ 9-204.01, 9-204.03, and 9-204.21), the Council designates the public alley system within Square 5730, bounded by Gainesville Street, S.E. and Hartford Street, S.E., as depicted by the plat in the committee report, as "Reverend Dr. Judy Talbert Street Designation Act of 2024".

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).
