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9	To amend Title 16 of the District of Columbia Official Code to make conforming changes; and
10	to amend An Act To establish a code of law for the District of Columbia to provide that
11	the age of marital consent shall be 18 years of age with no exceptions, and to prohibit the
12 13	Clerk from issuing a marriage license to any person who is under the age of 18.
14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
15	act may be cited as the "Child Marriage Prohibition Amendment Act of 2024".
16	Sec. 2. Title 16 of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended as follows:
17	(a) Section 16-904(d)(5) is amended to read as follows:
18	"(5) where either of the parties had not attained the age of 18, but in such cases
19	only at the suit of the party who had not attained such age.".
20	(b) Section 16-2301(20)(A) is amended by striking the phrase "marriage, enlistment" and
21	inserting the word "enlistment" in its place.
22	Sec. 3. An Act To establish a code of law for the District of Columbia, approved March
23	3, 1901 (31 Stat. 1391; D.C. Official Code § 46-401 passim), is amended as follows:
24	(a) Section 1285(4) (D.C. Official Code § 46-403(4)) is amended by striking the phrase
25	"16 years" and inserting the phrase "18 years" in its place.
26	(b) Section 1291 (D.C. Official Code § 46-410) is amended by striking the phrase

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27	"marry, and if they are under age the names of their parents or guardians," and inserting the
28	phrase "marry," in its place.
29	(c) Section 1292 (D.C. Official Code § 46-411) is amended to read as follows:
30	"Sec. 1292. Persons under 18 years of age.
31	"If any person intending to marry and seeking a license therefore shall be under 18 years
32	of age, the Clerk shall not issue such license.".
33	Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.
34	The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
35	impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
36	approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).
37	Sec. 5. Effective date.
88	This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
39	Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
10	provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
11	24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
12	Columbia Register.
