IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

---

To establish the Seniors with Disabilities Relocation Subsidy Program that will provide assistance for senior renters with disabilities in the District of Columbia to access and remain in affordable housing units in the District of Columbia.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Seniors with Disabilities Relocation Subsidy Act of 2024”.

Sec. 2. Establishment of the relocation subsidy program for seniors with disabilities.

(a) There is established the Seniors with Disabilities Relocation Subsidy program, Which shall be facilitated by the District of Columbia Housing Authority in accordance with this section;

(1) Annual review of appropriated funds to include a quarterly report to the District of Columbia Council, accounting of activities and revenue sources, public hearings and quarterly assessment of relocation needs for senior renters with disabilities.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the

53           This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto
