28	from the D.C. metropolitan area to speak up about issues of social justice;
29	WHEREAS, the DC Youth Poetry Slam Team has competed in the Brave New Voices
30	International Youth Poetry Slam Festival since 1998;

33	WHEREAS, in July 2014, the DC Youth Poetry Slam Team comprised of 12 students
34	from the DC metropolitan area, traveled to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania to compete against more
35	than 50 national and international teams of youth poets;
