






15 A CEREMONIAL RESOLUTION

18 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

24 To recognize the contributions that Wayne E. McOwen has made to the District upon the
25 occasion of his retirement as the Executive Director of the District of Columbia Insurance
26 Federation.

28 WHEREAS, Wayne E. McOwen served as the 3rd Executive Director of the District of
29 Columbia Insurance Federation (“DCIF”) for the past 18 years, creating a vision for the District
30 where everyone can live and thrive;

32 WHEREAS, Wayne E. McOwen had a 36-year record of tenure of professional activity in
33 the insurance marketplace prior to his tenure with DCIF;

35 WHEREAS, Wayne E. McOwen served as a valuable board member of Gallaudet
36 University and Maguire Academy of Risk Management and Insurance;

38 WHEREAS, Wayne E. McOwen continues to serve as the Executive Director of the
39 District of Columbia Insurance Regulatory Trust Fund;

41 WHEREAS, Wayne E. McOwen worked for 18 years with many members of the Council,
42 Mayors, Department of Insurance, Securities and Banking Commissioners, and numerous other
43 government agency professionals to create a consumer centric, flourishing insurance marketplace
44 in the District;

46 WHEREAS, Wayne E. McOwen announced his intention to fully retire from the DCIF on
47 December 31, 2022; and

50 Reception in March 2023.
