





IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To recognize and congratulate the Saint John’s College Boys’ Basketball team for winning the Washington Catholic Athletic Conference Boys’ Basketball Championship.

WHEREAS, St. John’s College High School, established in 1851 is the second-oldest Christian Brothers school in the United States;
