22 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

25 To recognize and honor the Woman’s National Democratic Club for working to educate, inform  
26 and inspire the women and men of the District of Columbia and beyond to engage in political  
27 action.

28 WHEREAS, the Woman’s National Democratic Club (WNDC) celebrated their 100 year  
29 anniversary in November 2022;

30 WHEREAS, the WNDC’s mission is to be a hub for civic engagement, learning and  
31 political action in the heart of the nation’s capital;

32 WHEREAS, the WNDC has hosted many notable politicians, dignitaries, and other  
33 speakers over the last century, most recently the newly elected Congress women of the 118<sup>th</sup>  
34 Congress and the 3 women who served on the January 6 committee; and, on many occasions,  
35 honored civic leaders-such as the Parkland Students, Dr. Dorothy Height and former Speaker of  
36 the House, Nancy Pelosi;

37 WHEREAS, the WNDC Public Policy and Political Action committee advocates on both  
38 national and international issues; and GOTV – Get Out the Vote - assist throughout the year  
39 supporting candidates running for office through letter writing and informing voters;

40 WHEREAS, the WNDC’s Educational Foundation was established in 1991 to preserve  
41 and educate the public on the history and accomplishments of women in the pursuit of social  
42 justice in the nation and the District of Columbia; as well as to reach out to youth and the  
43 community and preserve the Whittemore House in Dupont Circle;

44           Resolved, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, that this  
45 resolution be cited as the “Woman’s National Democratic Club Centennial Recognition  
46 Resolution of 2023”.

47           Sec.2. The Council of the District of Columbia honors the Woman’s National Democratic  
48 Club for its 100-year commitment to improving the lives of the citizens of the District of  
49 Columbia.

50           Sec.3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon the first date of publication in  
51 the district of Columbia Register.
