WHEREAS, Director Whitfield successfully reinvested nearly \$9 million dollars in fines levied and collected from prime contractors not meeting their required Small Business Enterprise spend goals, going directly back into the small business community ensuring that local dollars stay local;

WHEREAS, Director Whitfield led the creation of the digital version of the Green Book, making it more accessible to Small Business Enterprises ensuring that critical resources reach businesses that need assistance with navigating the local government procurement process;

WHEREAS, Director Whitfield led the effort for the District achieved record-breaking spend with Small Business Enterprises of over \$1 billion dollars within a fiscal year.

WHEREAS, Director Whitfield led DC Art All Night to flourish to become a cornerstone of the city's cultural calendar, with far-reaching positive impacts on the local economy where 22 DC Main Streets, four Business Improvement Districts, and seven DC libraries hosted over 600 activations at over 275 venues with 160,000 attendees across the city in 2022, making it the most successful Art All Night festival in its 11-year history;
