

A CEREMONAL RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To recognize Father Peter Weigand for his 60 years of service at the St. Anselm's Abbey School.

WHEREAS, Father Peter Weigand was born on October 4, 1941 and raised in Wisconsin;

WHEREAS, Father Peter Weigand studied biology at St. Mary's College in Winona, Minnesota and Philosophy and Theology at Catholic University;

WHEREAS, Father Peter Weigand arrived at St. Anselm's Abbey June 20, 1964;

WHEREAS, Father Peter Wiegand started teaching biology at the St. Anselm School in 1968;

WHEREAS, Father Peter Weigand was ordained a priest in May 1970;

WHEREAS, in 1999 Father Peter Weigand won the Principal of the Year award for the District of Columbia;

WHEREAS, Father Peter Weigand co-founded the National Capital Cactus and Succulent Society in 1980, and it meets every 3rd Sunday in the school for more than 45 years;

WHEREAS, Father Peter Weigand has taught science in the school for 54 consecutive years;

WHEREAS, Father Peter Weigand currently teaches Physical Anthropology, Native American Studies, and Earth Science; and

49 WHEREAS, Father Peter Weigand has held many positions at the St. Anselm Abbey's School and
50 Monastery including Second Master, Chaplain, Headmaster, President, and Grounds Master.
