WHEREAS, Dr. Ray's exemplary leadership qualities were recognized when he was 46 47 appointed as the Chairman of the Board of Dentistry from 1998 through 2008, demonstrating his commitment to upholding the highest standards of dental care and professional ethics; 48 49 WHEREAS, Dr. Ray provided strategic leadership and guidance as the chairman of the 50 Board of Dentistry, overseeing regulatory affairs and ensuring compliance with dental practice 51 standards; 52 53 54 WHEREAS, Dr. Ray was responsible for streamlining the license approval process, 55 reducing the timeline from three months to just one week; 56 57 WHEREAS, Dr. Ray represented the Board of Dentistry at conferences, seminars, and meetings to advocate for best practices and to stay abreast of industry advancements; 58 59 WHEREAS, Dr. Ray was appointed to the Board of Whitman Walker Health by 60 Councilmember Jim Graham and served 3 years; 61 62 63 WHEREAS, Dr. Ray's professional affiliations and achievements also include serving as president of the Robert T.
