WHEREAS, June’s long-standing membership at Vermont Avenue Baptist Church and her passion for globe-trotting have infused her life with joy and broadened her impact;

WHEREAS, June has lived at 5th and I Streets, NE, since 1947, deepening her roots in the community for more than 75 years; and

WHEREAS, June’s neighbors cherish her presence, and she is a pillar of the community.
