WHEREAS, the NCL has presented testimony on numerous worker and consumeroriented legislation to the Council of the District of Columbia;

WHEREAS, the NCL's success is based on its multi-faceted approach building coalitions, mounting public education campaigns and advancing improved legislation and policies;

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "National Consumers League 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Recognition Resolution of 2024".
