A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to reappoint Earl Woodland as a private sector management member of the Occupational Safety and Health Board.

RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this

resolution may be cited as the “Occupational Safety and Health Board Earl Woodland

Confirmation Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2014”.

Sec. 2(a) The emergency legislation will re-appoint Earl Woodland as a private sector management member of the Occupational Safety and Health Board for a term ending on April 12, 2017.

(b) Earl Woodland is an Occupational Safety and Health Administration Outreach Instruction with 5 years of training experience. He is also a Safety Trainer and Consultant with Woodland Safety Specialists LLC, where he conducts construction safety trainings on occupational Safety and Health Administration standards, inspects construction sites, and writes reports outlining the safety violations observed at construction sites and recommending corrective actions.

(c) Appointments to the Occupational Safety and Health Board require Council approval. With the Council period coming to an end, it is imperative that the appointment of Earl

1 Woodland be moved in order to have all seats on the Board occupied so that the members can
2 continue to work towards safer workplaces for District residents.

3 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
4 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
5 Occupational Safety and Health Board Earl Woodland Confirmation Emergency Resolution of
6 2014 be adopted after a single reading.

7 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
