23	Sec. 2. (a) On October 18, 2022, the Council passed the Attorney General Civil Rights
24	Enforcement Second Emergency Amendment Act of 2022, effective November 3, 2022 (D.C. Act
25	24-626; 69 DCR 14019) ("emergency act"). The emergency act will expire on February 1, 2023.
26	(b) On November 1, 2022, the Council passed the Attorney General Civil Rights
27	Enforcement Second Temporary Amendment Act of 2022, enacted on November 22, 2022 (D.C.
28	Act 24-664; 69 DCR 14758) ("temporary act"). The temporary act is now pending congressional
29	transmittal.
30	(c) To prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the
31	effective date of the temporary act, it is now necessary to pass this congressional review emergency
32	legislation.

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Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Attorney
General Civil Rights Enforcement Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2023
must be adopted after a single reading.

37 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
