(a) On October 18, 2022, the Council passed the Housing Authority 25 Accountability Emergency Amendment Act of 2022, effective November 3, 2022 (D.C. Act 24-26 629; 69 DCR 14026) ("emergency act"). The emergency act will expire on February 1, 2023. 27 (b) On November 1, 2022, the Council passed the Housing Authority Accountability 28 Temporary Amendment Act of 2022, enacted on November 22, 2022 (D.C. Act 24-666; 69 DCR 29 14762) ("temporary act"). The temporary act is now pending congressional review. 30 (c) To prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the 31 effective date of the temporary act, it is now necessary to pass congressional review emergency 32 legislation.

33	Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
34	enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
35	Housing Authority Accountability Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2023
36	must be adopted after a single reading.

Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

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
