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22 RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That
23 this resolution may be cited as the “Public Health Emergency Credit Alert Congressional
24 Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2023”.

25 Sec. 2. (a) On July 11, 2023, the Council adopted the “Public Health Emergency
26 Credit Alert Emergency Amendment Act of 2023”. The Act became law on July 31, 2023
27 and expires on October 29, 2023.

28 (b) On September 19, 2023, the Council adopted the “Public Health Emergency
29 Credit Alert Temporary Amendment Act of 2023.” The temporary measure was signed
30 by the Mayor on October 11, 2023.

31 (c) The measure has not completed its 30-day Congressional review period.

32 (d) This identical emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law
33 between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.
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35 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the
36 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it
37 necessary that the Public Health Emergency Credit Alert Congressional Review
38 Emergency Amendment Act of 2023 must be adopted after a single reading.

39 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
