17 disability or death shall be presumed to have been
18 accidental and to have been suffered in the line of duty unless
19 the contrary be shown by competent evidence. However, any such
20 firefighter or law enforcement officer must have successfully
21 passed a physical examination upon entering into any such
22 service as a firefighter or law enforcement officer, which
23 examination failed to reveal any evidence of any such
24 condition. The medical examination required by s. 633.412(5),
25 F.S., may serve as a physical examination upon entering service
26 for a firefighter. Such presumption does not apply to benefits
27 payable under or granted in a policy of life insurance or
28 disability insurance, unless the insurer and insured have
29 negotiated for such additional benefits to be included in the
30 policy contract.

31 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
