6 (b) Reports submitted to the department under this section
 7 are expressly declared subject to disclosure under the public
 8 records law and are not confidential or exempt.

9 (c) By March 1 of each year, the department shall submit a
 10 report to the Governor, the President of the Senate, the Speaker
 11 of the House of Representatives, and the chairs of the standing
 12 committees of the Senate and the House of Representatives with
 13 primary jurisdiction over criminal justice on the information
 14 provided pursuant to subsection (6) (a).

15 (d) The Office of State Court Administrator and State
 16 Attorneys must cooperate with the department to develop a
 17 methodology to gather data regarding requests for a warrant

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18 pursuant to subsection (2) and related information. The
19 department shall submit a report of their recommendations to the
20 Governor, the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House
21 of Representatives, and the chairs of the standing committees of
22 the Senate and the House of Representatives with primary
23 jurisdiction over criminal justice by October 1, 2015. The
24 report's recommendation must include a plan of implementation
25 and justification for all associated costs.
