17 (128) BOATING CAPITAL OF THE WORLD LICENSE PLATES.-

18 (a) The department shall develop a Boating Capital of the
19 World license plate as provided in this section and s.
20 320.08053. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by
21 the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
22 plate, and the words "Boating Capital of the World" must appear
23 at the bottom of the plate.

24 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate must be
25 distributed to Captain Sandy Yawn Inc., which may use up to 10
26 percent of such fees for administrative costs and marketing of
27 the plate. The balance of the fees shall be used by Captain
28 Sandy Yawn Inc., to increase public awareness of employment
