 8 395.1055, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

9 395.1055 Rules and enforcement.—

10 (9) The agency shall establish a technical advisory panel,  
 11 pursuant to s. 20.052, to develop procedures and standards for  
 12 measuring outcomes of pediatric cardiac catheterization programs  
 13 and pediatric cardiovascular surgery programs.

14 (b) Voting members of the panel shall include: 3 at-large  
 15 members, and 3 alternate at-large members with different program  
 16 affiliations, including 1 cardiologist who is board certified in

22 alternate for each member, each of whom is a pediatric  
23 cardiologist or a pediatric cardiovascular surgeon, each
