6 Between lines 24 and 25, insert:

7 (3) This section does not apply to the use of powdered
8 alcohol for research purposes by a:

9 (a) Health care provider that operates primarily for the
10 purpose of conducting scientific research;

11 (b) State institution;

12 (c) State university or private college or university; or

13 (d) Pharmaceutical or biotechnology company.

14 (4) This section does not apply to the possession of
15 powdered alcohol solely for the purpose of transportation
16 through this state by a licensed manufacturer or a common
17 carrier on behalf of a licensed manufacturer.

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18 (5) This section does not prohibit a manufacturer licensed
19 under the Beverage Law from manufacturing powdered alcohol in
20 this state for distribution and sale outside of the state.
