6 Remove lines 108-118 and insert:

7 (b) ~~(a)~~ Each county or municipality that operates a traffic  
 8 infraction detector shall submit a report by October 1, 2012,  
 9 and annually thereafter, to the department which details the  
 10 results of using the traffic infraction detector and the  
 11 procedures for enforcement for the preceding state fiscal year.  
 12 The information submitted by the counties and municipalities  
 13 must include:

- 14 1. The number of notices of violation issued, the number  
 15 that were contested, the number that were upheld, the number  
 16 that were dismissed, the number that were issued as uniform

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17 traffic citations, the number that were paid, and the number in  
18 each of the preceding categories for which the notice of  
19 violation was issued for a right-hand turn violation.

20 2. A description of alternative safety countermeasures  
21 taken prior to and after the placement or installation of a  
22 traffic infraction detector.

23 3. Statistical data and information required by the  
24 department to complete the summary report required under  
25 paragraph (c) ~~(b)~~.
