 12 Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section
 13 465.0275, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

14 465.0275 Emergency prescription refill.—

15 (1) In the event a pharmacist receives a request for a
 16 prescription refill and the pharmacist is unable to readily
 17 obtain refill authorization from the prescriber, the pharmacist
 18 may dispense:

19 (b) An ~~A one-time~~ emergency refill ~~of one vial~~ of insulin
 20 and insulin-related supplies or equipment to treat diabetes
 21 mellitus, not to exceed 3 nonconsecutive times per calendar
 22 year.

23 Section 2. Subsection (3) of section 893.04, Florida
 24 Statutes, is amended to read:

25 893.04 Pharmacist and practitioner.—

26 (3) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a pharmacist may
27 dispense a one-time emergency refill of up to a 72-hour supply
28 of the prescribed medication for any medicinal drug other than a
29 medicinal drug listed in Schedule II, or emergency refill ~~up to~~
30 ~~one vial~~ of insulin and insulin-related supplies or equipment to
31 treat diabetes mellitus, not to exceed 3 nonconsecutive times
32 per calendar year, in compliance with s. 465.0275.

33 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
