 2           An act relating to specialty license plates; amending  
 3           ss. 320.08056 and 320.08058, F.S.; directing the  
 4           Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to  
 5           create a Support Down Syndrome license plate;  
 6           establishing an annual use fee for the plate;  
 7           providing for the distribution of use fees received  
 8           from the sale of such plates; providing an effective  
 9           date.

11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

13           Section 1. Paragraph (iiii) is added to subsection (4) of  
 14 section 320.08056, Florida Statutes, to read:

15           320.08056 Specialty license plates.—

16           (4) The following license plate annual use fees shall be  
 17 collected for the appropriate specialty license plates:

18           (iiii) Support Down Syndrome license plate, \$25.

19           Section 2. Subsection (87) is added to section 320.08058,  
 20 Florida Statutes, to read:

21           320.08058 Specialty license plates.—

22           (87) SUPPORT DOWN SYNDROME LICENSE PLATES.—

23           (a) Notwithstanding s. 45, chapter 2008-176, Laws of  
 24 Florida, as amended by s. 21, chapter 2010-223 and s. 45,  
 25 chapter 2014-216, Laws of Florida, the department shall develop  
 26 a Support Down Syndrome license plate as provided in this

27 section. Support Down Syndrome license plates must bear the  
28 colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida"  
29 must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Support Down  
30 Syndrome" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

31 (b) The license plate annual use fees shall be distributed  
32 to Olivia's Angels Foundation, Inc., to fund its activities,  
33 programs, and projects within the state. Olivia's Angels  
34 Foundation, Inc., may retain all revenue from the annual use  
35 fees until all startup costs for developing and establishing the  
36 plate have been recovered. Thereafter, up to 10 percent of the  
37 annual use fee revenue may be used for administrative costs and  
38 promotion and marketing of the specialty license plate.

39 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
