4 revising the deadline for an annual report by law
5 enforcement agencies concerning property seized or
6 forfeited under the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act;
7 providing an effective date.
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9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
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11 Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 932.7061, Florida
12 Statutes, is amended to read:

13 932.7061 Reporting seized property for forfeiture.—

14 (1) Every law enforcement agency shall submit an annual
15 report to the Department of Law Enforcement indicating whether
16 the agency has seized or forfeited property under the Florida
17 Contraband Forfeiture Act. A law enforcement agency receiving or
18 expending forfeited property or proceeds from the sale of
19 forfeited property in accordance with the Florida Contraband
20 Forfeiture Act shall submit a completed annual report within 30
21 days after the end of its fiscal year ~~by October 10~~ documenting
22 the receipts and expenditures. The report shall be submitted in
23 an electronic form, maintained by the Department of Law
24 Enforcement in consultation with the Office of Program Policy
25 Analysis and Government Accountability, to the entity that has

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26 | budgetary authority over such agency and to the Department of
27 | Law Enforcement. The annual report must, at a minimum, specify
28 | the type, approximate value, court case number, type of offense,
29 | disposition of property received, and amount of any proceeds
30 | received or expended.

31 | Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
