 4 "recovered materials" to include certain wood,
 5 asphalt, and concrete materials; providing
 6 applicability; providing an effective date.

 8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 10 Section 1. Subsection (28) of section 403.703, Florida
 11 Statutes, is amended to read:

12 403.703 Definitions.—As used in this part, the term:
 13 (28) "Recovered materials" means metal, paper, glass,
 14 plastic, textile, ~~or~~ rubber, wood, asphalt, or concrete
 15 materials that have known recycling potential, can be feasibly
 16 recycled, and have been diverted and source separated or have
 17 been removed from the solid waste stream for sale, use, or reuse
 18 as raw materials, whether or not the materials require
 19 subsequent processing or separation from each other, but the
 20 term does not include materials destined for any use that
 21 constitutes disposal. Recovered materials as described in this
 22 subsection are not solid waste. For purposes of this subsection,
 23 the term "wood" does not include wood treated or coated with
 24 chemicals to resist decomposition or vegetative matter resulting
 25 from landscaping maintenance or land clearing operations that

26 | includes tree or shrub trimmings, grass clippings, palm fronds,
27 | trees, or tree stumps.

28 | Section 2. This act is not intended to impair, void, or
29 | cause the modification of any contract entered into before July
30 | 1, 2018.

31 | Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
