

1 A bill to be entitled

2 An act relating to voter registration maintenance;  
3 amending s. 98.065, F.S.; requiring supervisors of  
4 elections to enter into agreements with clerks of the  
5 circuit courts to receive specified information;  
6 requiring supervisors of elections to compare certain  
7 information with the statewide voter registration  
8 system; amending s. 98.093, F.S.; requiring the  
9 Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to  
10 furnish monthly to the Department of State a list of  
11 persons who identified themselves as aliens; requiring  
12 the Department of State to compare such list with the  
13 statewide voter registration system and provide the  
14 names of registered voters who are aliens to the  
15 supervisor of elections of the county in which the  
16 voter is registered; providing an effective date.

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18 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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20 Section 1. Paragraphs (a), (b), and (c) of subsection (4)  
21 of section 98.065, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as  
22 paragraphs (b), (c), and (d), respectively, and a new paragraph  
23 (a) is added to that subsection to read:

24 98.065 Registration list maintenance programs.—

26        (a) The supervisor shall enter into an agreement with the  
 27 local clerk of the circuit court to receive monthly from such  
 28 clerk change-of-address information and a list of potential  
 29 jurors who identified themselves as aliens, as defined in s.  
 30 327.02(2), during the preceding calendar month. Each list shall  
 31 include the name, address, date of birth, sex, and, whichever is  
 32 available, the Florida driver license number or Florida  
 33 identification card number of each such person. The supervisor  
 34 shall compare all of the information included in the list each  
 35 month with the statewide voter registration system.

36        Section 2. Paragraph (h) is added to subsection (2) of  
 37 section 98.093, Florida Statutes, to read:

38        98.093 Duty of officials to furnish information relating  
 39 to deceased persons, persons adjudicated mentally incapacitated,  
 40 ~~and~~ persons convicted of a felony, and persons identified as  
 41 aliens.-

42        (2) To the maximum extent feasible, state and local  
 43 government agencies shall facilitate provision of information  
 44 and access to data to the department, including, but not limited  
 45 to, databases that contain reliable criminal records and records  
 46 of deceased persons. State and local government agencies that  
 47 provide such data shall do so without charge if the direct cost  
 48 incurred by those agencies is not significant.

49        (h) The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles  
 50 shall furnish monthly to the department a list of persons who

51 identified themselves as aliens, as defined in s. 327.02(2),  
52 during the preceding calendar month. Each list shall include the  
53 name, address, date of birth, sex, and, whichever is available,  
54 the Florida driver license number or Florida identification card  
55 number of each such person. The department shall compare all of  
56 the information included in the list each month with the  
57 statewide voter registration system and if the department  
58 determines that a registered voter is an alien, provide the name  
59 of such voter to the supervisor of elections of the county in  
60 which the voter is registered.

61 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
