 2           An act relating to county delinquency programs and  
 3           facilities; amending s. 985.688, F.S.; deleting  
 4           provisions allowing a county to comply with juvenile  
 5           detention requirements by providing for  
 6           preadjudication detention in the facilities of the  
 7           county sheriff, another county jail operator, or a  
 8           contracted provider in certain circumstances;  
 9           providing an effective date.

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11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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13           Section 1. Subsection (11) of section 985.688, Florida  
 14 Statutes, is amended to read:

15           985.688 Administering county and municipal delinquency  
 16 programs and facilities.—

17           ~~(11) (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, a~~  
 18 ~~county is in compliance with this section if:~~

19           ~~1. The county provides the full cost for preadjudication~~  
 20 ~~detention for juveniles;~~

21           ~~2. The county authorizes the county sheriff, any other~~  
 22 ~~county jail operator, or a contracted provider located inside or~~  
 23 ~~outside the county to provide preadjudication detention care for~~  
 24 ~~juveniles;~~

25           ~~3. The county sheriff or other county jail operator is~~  
 26 ~~accredited by the Florida Corrections Accreditation Commission~~  
 27 ~~or American Correctional Association; and~~

28           ~~4. The facility is inspected annually and meets the~~

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29 ~~Florida Model Jail Standards.~~

30 ~~(b) A county or county sheriff may form regional detention~~  
31 ~~facilities through an interlocal agreement in order to meet the~~  
32 ~~requirements of this section.~~

33 ~~(c) Each county sheriff or other county jail operator must~~  
34 ~~follow the federal regulations that require sight and sound~~  
35 ~~separation of juvenile inmates from adult inmates.~~

36 ~~(d) A county or county sheriff that complies with this~~  
37 ~~subsection is not subject to any additional training,~~  
38 ~~procedures, or inspections required by this chapter.~~

39 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
