Code Section 49-6-92 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to Georgia Alzheimer's and Related Dementias State Plan Advisory Council, is amended by revising paragraph (6) of subsection (b) and subsection (f) as follows:

- "(6) Amending the state plan at least every three four years and submitting the amended state plan to the Governor for authorization."
- "(f) Starting on January 1, 2019 2027, and repeating every three four years after that date, the advisory council shall submit to the Governor for his or her review and approval and thereafter make available to the General Assembly an amended state plan which a report on the work of the advisory council. This report shall include a summary of the progress report toward implementation the goals of the prior state plan, analysis of dementia data, and recommendations for amendments to the state plan. If the advisory council determines that amendments need to be made to the state plan, an amended Georgia Alzheimer's and Related Dementia State Plan may be presented to the Governor for review and approval."
