

Senators Setzler of the 37th and Cowser of the 46th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend SB 494 (LC 55 0331S) by inserting before "to provide for related matters;" on line 22*  
 2 *the following:*

3 to amend Chapter 23 of Title 2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the  
 4 'Georgia Hemp Farming Act,' so as to regulate hemp products; to provide definitions; to  
 5 prohibit the sale of certain consumable hemp products;

6 *By inserting between lines 178 and 179 the following:*

7 **SECTION 3.**

8 Chapter 23 of Title 2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the 'Georgia  
 9 Hemp Farming Act,' is amended in Code Section 2-23-3, relating to definitions, by revising  
 10 paragraph (12) and adding new paragraphs to read as follows:

11 ~~“(1.1) 'Consumable hemp product' means a hemp product intended to be ingested,~~  
 12 ~~absorbed, or inhaled by humans or animals.”~~

13 ~~“(30) 'THC' means tetrahydrocannabinol, tetrahydrocannabinolic acid, or a combination~~  
 14 ~~of tetrahydrocannabinol and tetrahydrocannabinolic acid. and its derivatives, salts,~~  
 15 ~~isomers, salts of isomers, halogen analogues, or homologues. Such term shall include,~~  
 16 ~~without limitation, delta-8-tetrahydrocannabinol (delta-8-TCH),~~  
 17 ~~delta-9-tetrahydrocannabinol (delta-9-THC), delta-10-tetrahydrocannabinol~~  
 18 ~~(delta-10-THC), delta-11-tetrahydrocannabinol (delta-11-THC), and~~  
 19 ~~exo-tetrahydrocannabinol (Exo-THC).~~

20 ~~“(13) 'Total THC concentration' means the concentration of all forms of THC within a~~  
 21 ~~sample.”~~

22 *By inserting between lines 647 and 648 the following:*

**SECTION 14A.**

24 Said chapter is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

25 "2-23-9.4.26 (a) No consumable hemp product shall be sold or otherwise distributed in this state unless  
27 such product has a total THC concentration of not more than 0.3 percent on a dry weight  
28 basis.29 (b) Any person who violates the provisions of this Code section shall be guilty of a  
30 misdemeanor."
