A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 10 of Chapter 21 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to the Georgia Driver's Education Commission, so as to increase the additional
- 3 penalty for violation of traffic laws or ordinances under "Joshua's Law"; to provide for an
- 4 effective date and applicability; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 5 for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 10 of Chapter 21 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 the Georgia Driver's Education Commission, is amended by revising Code
- 10 Section 15-21-179, relating to additional penalty for violation of traffic laws or ordinances,
- 11 as follows:

- 12 "15-21-179.
- 13 (a) In every case in which any court in this state shall impose a fine or bond payment,
- which shall be construed to include costs, for any violation of the traffic laws of this state
- or for violations of ordinances of political subdivisions which have adopted by reference
- the traffic laws of this state, there shall be imposed as an additional penalty a sum equal to
- 17 $\frac{1.5}{3}$ percent of the original fine.
- 18 (b) Such sums shall be in addition to any amount required to be paid into any pension,
- annuity, or retirement fund under Title 47 or any other law and in addition to any other
- amounts provided for in this article.
- 21 (c) This Code section shall be repealed in its entirety on June 30, 2022, unless extended
- by an Act of the General Assembly."

SECTION 2.

- 24 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2020, and shall apply to offenses committed on
- or after that date.
