

House Bill 1053 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating a new board of education of Grady County, approved March 5,  
2 1968 (Ga. L. 1968, p. 2120), as amended, so as to provide that members of the board of  
3 education shall be elected on a nonpartisan basis; to provide for continuation in office of  
4 current members of the board; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date;  
5 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act creating a new board of education of Grady County, approved March 5, 1968 (Ga.  
9 L. 1968, p. 2120), as amended, is amended by revising subsection (c) of Section 2B as  
10 follows:

11 "(c) All members of the board who are elected thereto shall be nominated and elected on  
12 a nonpartisan basis in accordance with Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the 'Georgia  
13 Election Code.'"

14 **SECTION 2.**

15 Those members of the Board of Education of Grady County who are serving as such on the  
16 effective date of this Act and any person selected to fill a vacancy in any such office shall  
17 continue to serve as such members until the regular expiration of their respective terms of  
18 office and upon the election and qualification of their respective successors.

19 **SECTION 3.**

20 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
21 without such approval.

22 **SECTION 4.**

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
