A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To provide for a homestead exemption from City of Eatonton ad valorem taxes for municipal
2	purposes in the amount of \$10,000.00 of the assessed value of the homestead for residents
3	of that city; to provide for definitions; to specify the terms and conditions of the exemption
4	and the procedures relating thereto; to provide for applicability; to provide for a referendum,
5	effective dates, and automatic repeal; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
7	SECTION 1.
8	(a) As used in this Act, the term:
9	(1) "Ad valorem taxes for municipal purposes" means all ad valorem taxes for municipal
10	purposes levied by, for, or on behalf of the City of Eatonton, including, but not limited
11	to, any ad valorem taxes to pay interest on and to retire municipal bonded indebtedness.
12	(2) "Homestead" means homestead as defined and qualified in Code Section 48-5-40 of
13	the O.C.G.A., as amended.
14	(b) Each resident of the City of Eatonton is granted an exemption on that person's homestead
15	from City of Eatonton ad valorem taxes for municipal purposes in the amount of \$10,000.00
16	of the assessed value of that homestead. The value of that property in excess of such
17	exempted amount shall remain subject to taxation.
18	(c) A person shall not receive the homestead exemption granted by subsection (b) of this
19	section unless such person or person's agent files an application with the governing authority
20	of the City of Eatonton, or the designee thereof, giving such information relative to receiving
21	such exemption as will enable the governing authority of the City of Eatonton, or the
22	designee thereof, to make a determination regarding the initial and continuing eligibility of
23	such person for such exemption. The governing authority of the City of Eatonton, or the
24	designee thereof, shall provide application forms for this purpose.
25	(d) The exemption shall be claimed and returned as provided in Code Section 48-5-50.1 of
26	the O.C.G.A., as amended. The exemption shall be automatically renewed from year to year

as long as the person granted the homestead exemption under subsection (b) of this section occupies the residence as a homestead. After a person has filed the proper application as provided in subsection (c) of this section, it shall not be necessary to make application thereafter for any year, and the exemption shall continue to be allowed to such person. It shall be the duty of any person granted the homestead exemption under subsection (b) of this section to notify the governing authority of the City of Eatonton, or the designee thereof, in the event that person for any reason becomes ineligible for such exemption.

(e) The exemption granted by subsection (b) of this section shall not apply to or affect any
state ad valorem taxes, county ad valorem taxes for county purposes, or county or
independent school district ad valorem taxes for educational purposes. The homestead
exemption granted by subsection (b) of this section shall be in addition to and not in lieu of
any other homestead exemption applicable to City of Eatonton ad valorem taxes for
municipal purposes.

40 (f) The exemption granted by subsection (b) of this section shall apply to all taxable years41 beginning on or after January 1, 2015.

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SECTION 2.

43 The municipal election superintendent of the City of Eatonton shall call and conduct an 44 election as provided in this section for the purpose of submitting this Act to the electors of the City of Eatonton for approval or rejection. The municipal election superintendent shall 45 46 conduct that election on the date of the 2014 November general election and shall issue the 47 call and conduct that election as provided by general law. The municipal election 48 superintendent shall cause the date and purpose of the election to be published once a week for two weeks immediately preceding the date thereof in the official organ of Putnam 49 50 County. The ballot shall have written or printed thereon the words:

51 "() YES Shall the Act be approved which provides a homestead exemption from City
52 of Eatonton ad valorem taxes for municipal purposes in the amount of
53 () NO \$10,000.00 of the assessed value of the homestead for residents of that
54 city?"

All persons desiring to vote for approval of the Act shall vote "Yes," and all persons desiring 55 56 to vote for rejection of the Act shall vote "No." If more than one-half of the votes cast on 57 such question are for approval of the Act, Section 1 of this Act shall become of full force and effect on January 1, 2015. If the Act is not so approved or if the election is not conducted 58 59 as provided in this section, Section 1 of this Act shall not become effective, and this Act shall 60 be automatically repealed on the first day of January immediately following that election 61 date. The expense of such election shall be borne by the City of Eatonton. It shall be the municipal election superintendent's duty to certify the result thereof to the Secretary of State. 62

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SECTION 3.

- 64 Except as otherwise provided in Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall become effective upon
- 65 its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.

SECTION 4.

67 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
