## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Subpart 2A of Part 3 of Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of
- 2 Georgia Annotated, relating to the needs based financial aid program, so as to provide for a
- 3 definition; to extend an automatic repealer; to provide for related matters; to provide for an
- 4 effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Subpart 2A of Part 3 of Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 8 Annotated, relating to the needs based financial aid program, is amended by revising
- 9 paragraph (1) of Code Section 20-3-360, relating to definitions, as follows:
- 10 "(1) 'Eligible student' means a person:
- 11 (A) Whose family income is considered economically disadvantaged, based on criteria
- established by the commission, or who has a financial aid gap;
- 13 (B) Who meets any academic or other standards established by the commission;
- (C) Who is eligible for a scholarship or grant pursuant to Code Section 20-3-519.1;
- 15 (D) Who has completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA); and
- 16 (E) Who has completed:

17 (i) Seventy 80 percent of the credit requirements toward the credential of his or her program of study, if such program is a four-year program; or 18 (ii) Forty-five percent of the credit requirements toward the credential of his or her 19 program of study, if such program is a two-year program." 20 21 **SECTION 2.** 22 Said subpart is further amended by revising Code Section 20-3-366, relating to repealer, as 23 follows: "20-3-366. 24 25 This subpart shall stand repealed by operation of law on June 30, 2025 2027." 26 **SECTION 3.** This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law 27 28 without such approval. 29 **SECTION 4.** 30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
