## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Chapter 2 of Title 46 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Public Service Commission, so as to provide that the authority and jurisdiction of the commission shall not extend to any person or entity not otherwise subject to the authority and jurisdiction of the commission that is engaged in the retail sale of electricity to the public for the sole purpose of charging the batteries of electric vehicles; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## **SECTION 1.**

9 Chapter 2 of Title 46 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Public
10 Service Commission, is amended by adding a new subsection to Code Section 46-2-20,
11 relating to the jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission generally and the powers and
12 duties of the commission generally, to read as follows:

13 "(k) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the authority and jurisdiction of the 14 commission shall not extend to a person or entity not otherwise subject to the authority and 15 jurisdiction of the commission that is engaged in the retail sale, as such term is defined in
