

House Bill 1150

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-8-73.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 tinting of windows or windshields of motor vehicles, so as to provide that fingerprints shall
3 not be obtained for offenses relating to operation of a motor vehicle with unauthorized levels
4 of window or windshield tinting or unlawful installation of such; to provide for related
5 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 40-8-73.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to tinting of
9 windows or windshields of motor vehicles, is amended by revising subsection (h) as follows:
10 "(h) Any person who violates subsection (b) or (e) of this Code section shall be guilty of
11 a misdemeanor, provided, however that no fingerprints shall be obtained for an offense of
12 this Code section."

13 **SECTION 2.**

14 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
