## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 40 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 tattoo studios, so as to require such studios to post notification that certain tattoos could
- 3 disqualify the wearer from military service; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 4 purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 6 SECTION 1.
- 7 Chapter 40 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to tattoo studios,
- 8 is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 9 "31-40-11.
- Each tattoo studio shall conspicuously display in a prominent place easily seen by patrons
- 11 <u>a printed sign that warns that any tattoo on the face, neck, forearm, hand, or lower leg may</u>
- 12 <u>automatically disqualify the wearer from military service in the United States armed forces.</u>
- Such notice shall be at least 11 inches by 14 inches in size, with letters at least one inch
- 14 <u>high.</u>"
- 15 SECTION 2.
- 16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
