A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to alcoholic beverages, so as to authorize local governing authorities to allow Sunday sales at wine bars or wine shops; to provide a definition; to provide for a short title; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6	SECTION 1.
7	This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Sunday Wine Bar and Wine Shop Act."
8	SECTION 2.
9	Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to alcoholic beverages, is
10	amended by adding a new subsection to Code Section 3-3-7, relating to local authorization
11	and regulation of sale of alcoholic beverages on Sunday, to read as follows:

12 "(s)(1) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, in all counties or municipalities in 13 which the sale of wine is lawful on Sundays, the governing authority of the county or 14 municipality, as appropriate, may by adoption of a resolution or an ordinance authorize 15 the sale of wine by a wine bar or wine shop on Sundays at all times that sales of wine by

- any other retailers are lawful on Sundays within the county or municipality in which the
 wine bar or wine shop is located.
 (2) As used in this subsection, the term 'wine bar' or 'wine shop' means any premises at
 which a retailer licensed to sell wine pursuant to this title sells wine but not any other
 alcoholic beverages."
- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 23 without such approval.
- 24 **SECTION 3.**
- 25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
