A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 1 of Article 2 of Chapter 13 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to schedules, offenses, and penalties regarding controlled substances, so
- 3 as to clarify that the sale, manufacture, delivery, or possession of four grams or more of
- 4 fentanyl and fentanyl analog structural class is within the prohibition of trafficking certain
- 5 drugs; to provide for an effective date; to provide for applicability; to provide for related
- 6 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Part 1 of Article 2 of Chapter 13 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 10 relating to schedules, offenses, and penalties regarding controlled substances, is amended by
- 11 revising subsection (b) of Code Section 16-13-31, relating to trafficking in cocaine, illegal
- 12 drugs, marijuana, or methamphetamine and penalties, as follows:
- 13 "(b) Except as authorized by this article, any person who sells, manufactures, delivers,
- brings into this state, or has possession of four grams or more of any morphine, opium,
- 15 <u>fentanyl or fentanyl analog structural class</u>, or substance identified in subparagraph (RR)
- or (SS) of paragraph (1) or paragraph (13), (14), or (15) of Code Section 16-13-25, or

subparagraph (A), (C.5), (F), (U.1), (V), or (V.2) of paragraph (2) of Code Section

- 18 16-13-26 or any salt, isomer, or salt of an isomer thereof, including heroin, as described in
- 19 Schedules I and II, or four grams or more of any mixture containing any such substance in
- violation of this article commits the felony offense of trafficking in illegal drugs and, upon
- 21 conviction thereof, shall be punished as follows:
- 22 (1) If the quantity of such substances involved is four grams or more, but less than 14
- grams, the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of
- 24 five years and shall pay a fine of \$50,000.00;
- 25 (2) If the quantity of such substances involved is 14 grams or more, but less than 28
- grams, the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of
- ten years and shall pay a fine of \$100,000.00; and
- 28 (3) If the quantity of such substances involved is 28 grams or more, the person shall be
- sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of 25 years and shall pay a fine
- 30 of \$500,000.00."
- 31 SECTION 2.
- 32 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2024, and shall apply to all offenses committed
- 33 on or after such date.
- 34 SECTION 3.
- 35 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
