A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act providing for a new charter for the county-wide government of Columbus,
- 2 Georgia, approved April 5, 1993 (Ga. L. 1993, p. 4978), as amended, so as authorize a tax
- 3 for public health care purposes; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 4 for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 An Act providing for a new charter for the county-wide government of Columbus, Georgia,
- 8 approved April 5, 1993 (Ga. L. 1993, p. 4978), as amended, is amended by revising
- 9 paragraph (2) of Section 7-102 to read as follows:
- 10 "(2) For the purpose of paying the ordinary current expenses of the consolidated
- government, the Council is hereby empowered and authorized to levy and collect an ad
- valorem tax upon all property within said government subject to taxation, not to
- exceed 18 mills upon the assessed value of said property for the year 1971, and 18 mills
- upon the assessed value of said property for each year thereafter; provided, however, that
- this limitation shall not be deemed to apply to an additional ad valorem tax for public
- health care purposes as may be determined by the Council, nor to any tax to which such

limitation is not applicable under the law. In the event that a local option sales and use tax is enacted by the Council of Columbus, Georgia, said 18 mills limitation shall be reduced to 9 mills for the year following the initial year in which the sales and use tax is enacted and for each year thereafter."
